## RESOLUTION

### Urging Macon County Residents to Take Measures to Reduce the Spread of COVID-19

**Whereas**, Macon County is experiencing an alarming increase of COVID-19 cases, the Macon County Board of Health believes it is necessary to take actions to slow the spread of COVID-19 to ensure the health, safety and welfare of our residents.

**THEREFORE**, as a matter of policy, it is resolved by the

**MACON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH** that:

1. All residents over the age of 2 are urged to wear cloth face coverings when outside of the home in a public setting.
2. All residents should maintain a distance of at least 6 feet apart when outside of the home in a public setting.
3. All residents should practice good hand hygiene.
4. All residents experiencing symptoms or those who may have been exposed to COVID-19 should be tested at their medical provider or local health department.
5. We are urging all residents and community leaders to have no events or gatherings of over 10 persons until July 11, 2020.
