## RESOLUTION

## Urging Macon County Residents to Take Measures to Reduce the Spread of COVID-19

Whereas, Macon County is experiencing an alarming increase of COVID-19 cases, the Macon County Board of Health believes it is necessary to take actions to slow the spread of COVID-19 to ensure the health, safety and welfare of our residents.

THEREFORE, as a matter of policy, it is resolved by the

## MACON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH that:

- 1. All residents over the age of 2 are urged to wear cloth face coverings when outside of the home in a public setting.
- 2. All residents should maintain a distance of at least 6 feet apart when outside of the home in a public setting.
- 3. All residents should practice good hand hygiene.

- 4. All residents experiencing symptoms or those who may have been exposed to COVID-19 should be tested at their medical provider or local health department.
- 5. We are urging all residents and community leaders to have no events or gatherings of over 10 persons until July 11, 2020.
